Mock trial on tort law

The activity is divided into two phases. The general coordinator will prepare the case study on the mock trial (establishment of the facts) and its simulation, with the support of specialized professionals (lawyers and economists) so that the attendants can be provided with the recording of the complete mock trial no longer than 30 minutes.

Then, during the second stage, starting after watching the recording, each of the working groups - whose members will be national and foreign attendants - will be coordinated by the participating judge, in charge of directing the discussions on the raised issues and the drafting of the final conclusions.

The mock trial will be related to a decision issued by the Commission on the cartels of track producers.
